

· National Capitol ·

Considered the most symbolic building of Havana, the National Capitol was reborn in 2019 on the occasion of the celebrations for the 500th anniversary of the foundation of San Cristóbal de La Habana.

Duration: Up to 1 hour Days: From Tuesday to Saturday. Hours: 10 AM, 11 AM, 1PM, 2 PM, 3 PM This building was restored by the Office of the Historian of the City to turn into the seat of the legislative body of the Republic of Cuba: the National Assembly (Cuban Parliament).

· Leal House Route·

A specialized tour conceived to interpret the symbolic capital of the late Historian of Havana by delving into his life, work and legacy.

Duration: Up to 3 hours. Days: From Monday to Friday. Languages: Spanish and English. Other languages according to availability. Our tour guides will lead take visitors to places where Leal's presence was more notorious. The route ends at the cemetery where the remains of the Eternal Historian rest in peace.

· Leal's Path·

It provides visitors with the sensorial assistance systems installed in Old Havana's golden kilometre by means of equipment, means and mainly guides aiming to offer an active and humane approach to the heritage of the capital city.

This tour includes an app for mobile phones that proposes four routes to rediscover those streets, monuments and buildings of the historic centre that witnessed the hard work done by the City Historian, Eusebio Leal Spengler.

· The Cradle of the City·

The tour begins at the entrance to the Square of Arms stopping to visit El Templete, the open area of the Castle of the Royal Guard, with an explanation of the defence system of Havana and its history, the former Vice-governor's Palace and the City Museum. The tour ends on the wooden street and the sculpture of Eusebio Leal. Access to the buildings by means of ramps with the possibility of visiting the ground floor of the palace and the fortress.

THEMED TOURS





The tour takes the traveller to the main squares and their connecting streets both to discover the rebirth of the old city and to corroborate its marked residential character and the continuity of its traditions. The daily life of local inhabitants merges with the rich legacy of colonial times in this walk through the historic centre. Accompanied by specialized guides, the traveller will get to know the facets of Havana with the expertise of illustrious and well-documented voices, as well as with the charisma and nicety of the city dwellers.

Duration: Up to 3 hours. Days: From Monday to Sunday

- Heritage Rehabilitation and Scial Worl

This offer emphasizes on the sociocultural importance – including the educational dimension – that the rehabilitation of heritage by the Office of the Historian has had in Old Havana.

Duration: Up to 3 hours. Days: From Monday to Sunday. The visits to the former Convent of Our Lady of Bethlehem, the walking tour to pass by social institutions, the trade schools and the centre for the rehabilitation with motion disabilities are in the crucible of opportunities to get to know the social integration and development projects of the Office of the Historian.

An approach to several examples of religious heritage in the historic centre, as well as to the practices and other expressions of popular religiosity, both of Christian and Afro-Cuban origin.

Duration: Up to 3 hours. Days: From Monday to Sunday It consists of a walking tour to see institutions and buildings such as the Cathedral of Havana, the Church of the Mercy and the Church of the Holy Angel, with locations, design and history that make them essential to interpret the development of the religious consciousness not only on local level but also in the whole country.

Art in Havana lives both in exhibition rooms and in the open air. The special interpretation of visual arts from yesterday and today concerning the heritage of the city is a glimpse of intimate and passionate looks.

The agency will take you along a time line to appreciate the main periods of the development of contemporary art in the context of the historic centre. The visit to the Building of Cuban Art of the National Museum of Fine Arts will close this experience on a high note in our island, recognized by Trip Advisor as a top cultural destination in the world.

- Gateway and Key to the New World -

The colonial fortification system around the Bay of Havana, included along with the historic centre in the declaration of World Cultural Heritage by UNESCO in 1982, still shows the defensive needs of San Cristóbal de La Habana, which became the port of call of the Spanish merchant fleet and target for corsairs and pirates. A walking tour in the historic centre to see the fragments of the former city walls and visit to fortresses, watchtowers and castles located in the territory.

Tabano Cigars and Rum, atradition of excellence.

Cuban rum and cigars are born from two iconic Cuban crops. This experience going from the soil to the know-how of rum masters, cigar rollers, tasters and professional bartenders holds the key to a heritage of aromas and flavours deeply rooted in the Cuban identity.

A tour through the culture of Cuban eigars and rum with emphasis on their condition of immaterial heritage thanks to the mastery and trade of their producers. It includes visits to Habano House and the Rum Museum.
